Zenith Youth Theatre Company and COVID Restrictions

Due the ever-changing environment Zenith have devised the following plans to deal with guidelines set out by the government.

All rehearsals are either over zoom or in person and in compliance with the Outside of School Setting guidelines set out by the Government. These guidelines are monitored on a weekly basis and rehearsals are adapted to ensure compliance.

The Open-Air Performances (under projected guidelines of performances being allowed with some restrictions) will all comply with social distancing measures for audiences and cast and conditions may change as restrictions are relaxed. A full breakdown of measures will be available on our website for audiences who want some assurances before their visit. Audience capacity will be restricted to 60 to ensure amply space for social distancing within the open-air performance space in the grounds of Barrow Castle. We aim to be on the cautious side of all government guidelines and will work hard to ensure all our cast and audiences feel safe.

What happens if public performances are not allowed – We have in place agreements with the rights holders of all three shows to be able to stage a live or pre-recorded (paid for ticket) performance for streaming online. Details of this will be released if and when we need to implement this facility. All bookers will be notified of any changes prior to performance.

Barrow Castle



Performances will be within the grounds of the historic Barrow Castle originally built in mid 1700's but destroyed by fire and rebuilt in 1851. In1890 it was bought by Mr Ware of Ware's Nurseries. In the 1960's the Meering family bought the nursery business and eventually relocated the business to the current Hilliers Garden

Centre site. The Current owners bought the house in March 2000 and run a training / retreat business from their family home.

The local area is steeped in ancient history. It was originally called barawe or BYREGE and was probably a medieval fortified hill. Archaeological excavations in 1954 and 1964 found iron age, Roman and medieval artefacts. Woden's Dyke runs through the fields opposite the house, and the Roman Fosse way runs at the top of the valley.
